MUSICAL INSTRUMENT REPAIR TECHNICIAN

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This position exists in the BOCES Educational Communication Center and involves responsibility for adjustment, cleaning, and repair of woodwind and brass musical instruments. The work is performed in accordance with general policies outlined by the Director of Educational Communications with wide leeway allowed for exercise of independent judgment. Supervision is not a responsibility of the class. The incumbent does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Replaces pads, corks, springs, and reeds in woodwind and brass musical instruments;
Adjusts and oils a variety of musical instruments;
Cleans, polishes, and removes dents from woodwind and brass instruments;
Stores a variety of musical instruments used by students in educational centers.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS ABILITIES & PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of maintenance and repair of woodwind and brass instruments;
Ability to solder and use hand tools in instruments repair;
Good hand and eye coordination.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Two (2) years of training and/or experience in the maintenance and repair of woodwind and brass musical instruments.
