SECTION 1: The Town of Schuyler Falls, Clinton County, New York, in the years 1972 and 1973 incurred bills \$50,783.71 in excess of budgeted amounts for those years as defined in subdivision (1) of County Law Section 227.

SECTION 2: Deficits and unbudgeted items are found as follows:

A. General Fund	\$19,290.82
B. Highway Department Fund	10,982.89
C. Highway Department Fund, Item III	2,082.56
D. Highway Department Fund, Item IV	2,710.52
E. Unbudgeted items	<u>15,716.92</u>

TOTAL \$50,783.71

SECTION 3: Pursuant to said Section 227 of the County Law, said Town of Schuyler Falls is hereby authorized and directed to pay said sums forthwith.

SECTION 4: The Town of Schuyler Falls is hereby authorized to issue serial bonds for payment of said claims hereinabove legalized, validated and authorized payments. Such Serial Bonds shall be issued pursuant to Subdivision 33 of paragraph (a) of Section 11:00 of the Local Finance Law and the period of probable usefulness thereof shall be three years, and such Serial Bonds shall be issued not later than October 31, 1974.

SECTION 5: This Local Law shall be effective immediately.


