Section I. Legislative Intent:

The County of Clinton heretofore having recognized the increased complexity of County Government and the necessity to adequately compensate its re-elected officials in the offices of County Treasurer, Clerk, and Sheriff to recognize their level of experience. It also recognizes these elected officials are department heads and that their salaries are not commensurate with other county departments, having similar responsibilities. It also recognizes that longevity amounts given to department heads after serving an established number of years should also apply to the aforementioned elected positions. It also recognizes that the intent of Local Law #1 of 1986 was to make the base salaries of said positions equal.

Section II. County Clerk:

The base salary of the County Clerk for the year 2003 shall be \$49,101.

Section III. County Treasurer:

The base salary of the County Treasurer for the year 2003 shall be \$49,101.

Section IV. County Sheriff:

The base salary of the County Sheriff for the year 2003 shall be \$49,101.

Section V. Salaries for Subsequent years:

The base salaries for the subsequent years for the office of County Clerk, County Treasurer, and County Treasurer shall not be increased unless such increases are applied equally to each office.

Section VI. Longevity Amounts:

A longevity amount of \$500 will be applied each time the person holding the office of County Clerk, County Treasurer and County Sheriff completes ten years, fifteen years, twenty years, twenty-five years, etc. of service in those elected positions.

Section VII. Effective Date:

The effective date of this Local Law shall be the first day of January 2003 and shall replace Local Law #1 of 1986 for the establishment of the salaries for County Clerk, County Treasurer, and County Sheriff. This provision shall be retroactive if any of the officeholders have ten years of service or more.

Section VIII. Separability:

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any Court or Competent Jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgement, decree or order shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which the judgement, decree or order shall have been rendered and the remainder of this Local Law shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and affect.
