## AWARDING REQUESTS FOR PROPOSALS (RFPs) FOR TRANSIT MANAGEMENT SERVICES – CLINTON COUNTY PUBLIC TRANSIT (CCPT)

WHEREAS, Clinton County Public Transit (CCPT) is operated by a contracted transit management company selected through a Request for Proposals (RFP) process; and

WHEREAS, Clinton County solicited for transit management services most recently for CCPT in 2015; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the 2015 solicitation, McDonald Transit Associates, Inc. has been the contracted operator of CCPT since July of 2015; and

WHEREAS, the current contract with McDonald Transit Associates, Inc. is from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, due to increasing costs, Clinton County is soliciting RFPs for transit management services at this time prior to the expiration of the five-year period; and

WHEREAS, Resolution #723 from September 13, 2017 authorized the Purchasing Agent to solicit for transit management services; and

WHEREAS, following approval from the New York State Department of Transportation, an RFP for transit management services was issued in February of 2018; and
