

This is a position in the Clinton County Health Department that involves responsibility for the investigation and inspection of the non-engineering aspects of environmental health control and enforcing and determining compliance with the provisions of Public Health Law, and local and State Sanitary Codes, and New York State Codes, Rules, and Regulations relating to environmental health, sanitation and safety.

Qualifications: Either: (a) Bachelor's Degree including thirty (30) semester credit hours in the *natural sciences OR (b) Associate's Degree with a minimum of fifteen (15) semester credit hours in *natural sciences and five (5) years of experience as a Public Health Technician deemed satisfactory by the local commissioner of health or public health director during which time you must have satisfactorily completed a public health training course approved by the New York State Health Department; OR (c) Completion of sixty (60) semester credit hours of academic education at regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a minimum of fifteen (15) credit hours in *natural sciences of which not more than six (6) credit hours may be in the **applied sciences and five (5) years of experience as a Public Health Technician deemed satisfactory by the local commissioner of health or public health director during which time you must have satisfactorily completed a public health training course approved by the New York State Health Department.

This title has been approved without the need to take an exam for a one year period ending September 24, 2024, through the HELP Program of the NYS Department of Civil Service. Candidates appointed permanently to this title will NOT need to take an exam and will remain in their position even when the HELP Program ends.

Position starts at \$52,971/yearly and includes a full benefits package.
