Chairperson Henry stated at this point, this was not an official meeting. As such, in accordance with Section 152 of the County Law, a resolution must be approved to authorize the convening of this meeting.

Chairperson Henry asked Michael Zurlo, the County Administrator and Clerk of the Board, to read the title of Resolution #630 titled, "Authorizing the County Legislature to Hold a Special Legislative Meeting on Wednesday, September 7, 2022 at 5:00 p.m."

He stated the Legislature was now in an official meeting for the sole purpose of Lead Agency Status under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) for a project in the Town of Schuyler Falls.

Chairperson Henry asked Mr. Zurlo to read the title of Resolution #631 titled, "Establishing the Intent of Clinton County as Lead Agency to Design and Construct the Water System Improvements to Address Emerging Contaminants Project."

Discussion: Legislator Potiker motioned to approve the resolution, seconded by Legislator Bezio. Carried (10-0-0).

Mr. Zurlo stated this resolution establishes the County as Lead Agency for a proposed project. The Board will decide on the project pending a grant award (hopefully) by the State of New York under the Water Infrastructure Improvement Act (WIIA) Program and potentially a Federal grant as well.

Chairperson Henry asked Mr. Zurlo to read the title of Resolution #632 titled, "Determining that the Proposed Clinton County Morrisonville Water Main Extension Project is a Type 1 Action and will not have a Significant Adverse Impact on the Environment."

Discussion: Legislator Hughes motioned to approve the resolution, seconded by Legislator Kretser. Carried (10-0-0).

There being no further business to come before the Legislature, Legislator Potiker motioned to adjourn at 5:04 p.m., seconded by Legislator Bezio. Carried (10-0-0).
