

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1951

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING A PETTY CASH FUND
FOR THE COUNTY TREASURER

Be It enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
Clinton as follows:

Section 1. That there be established a petty cash fund in
the amount of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars in the office of the
Clinton County Treasurer for the purpose of making change.

Section 2. Subject to the provisions of Section 306 of the
County Law, this act shall become effective on the twentieth day
after it shall have been adopted.
