LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1956

COUNTY OF CLINTON, NEW YORK

A local law to provide for continuation of the Workmen's Compensation Mutual Plan, and the conversion thereof to a County Self-Insurance Plan, pursuant to Workmen's Compensation Law, Article 5.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Clinton as follows:

Section 1. The Workmen's Compensation Mutual Plan established pursuant to former section 50 (3-a) of the Workmen's Compensation Law is hereby continued in existence through December 31, 1956, when it shall become the Clinton County Self-Insurance Plan.

Section 2. The governing board of each municipality participating in the present mutual plan shall by resolution signify its election to participate in the Clinton County Self-Insurance Plan. A certified copy of such resolution shall be filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors by August 1, 1956.

Section 3. An administrator shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors to administer the plan.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect July 1, 1956.
