A local law CREATING THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CLINTON COUNTY LEGISLATURE PURSUANT TO SECTION 10 OF THE MUNICIPAL HOME RULE LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK

Section 1. There is hereby established the office of Administrative Assistant to the Chairman of the Clinton County Legislature.

Section 2. The Administrative Assistant shall perform his duties under the general supervision of the Chairman of the Clinton County Legislature.

Section 3. The Administrative Assistant shall perform such administrative functions and duties and shall hold such powers as shall be designated by the Chairman of the Clinton County Legislature.

Section 4. The Administrative Assistant shall provide the Chairman of the Clinton County Legislature and the Clinton County Legislature with reports at such periods as he may be directed.

Section 5. This local law shall not divest the Clinton County Legislature of any of its functions, powers and duties provided by law.

Section 6. This local law shall take effect immediately.
