A local law FOR FILLING OF VACANCIES ON THE CLINTON COUNTY BOARD OF LEGISLATORS (Insert title)

Be it enacted by the CLINTON COUNTY LEGISLATURE of the (Name of Legislative Body)

SECTION I. If a vacancy occurs in the office of the County Legislature, otherwise than by expiration of the term, the County Legislature shall fill the office within thirty (30) days of the vacancy by appointment of a resident of the district or area represented by said vacant office.

SECTION II. A person appointed pursuant to Section I, to execute the duties of the office of County Legislator, shall continue until the vacancy shall be filled at the next general election. But if the term of such officer shall expire within the calendar year in which the appointment shall be made, the appointee shall hold said office for the residue of the term.

SECTION III. This local law shall take effect immediately.

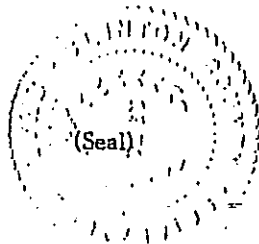


