Section 1. The purpose of this law is to provide that no exemption from real property taxes shall be granted pursuant to section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of subdivision 4 of section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, no exemption from real property taxes shall be granted pursuant to section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law for purposes of real property taxes levied for the County of Clinton.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
