- Individuals who qualify under the provisions of Section 459-c of the Real Property Tax Law shall receive a real property tax exemption to the extent provided in the following schedule:

<u>ANNUAL INCOME</u>	<u>PERCENTAGE OF ASSESSED VALUATION EXEMPT FROM TAXATION</u>
Up to \$20,500	50 per centum
More than \$20,500, but less than \$21,000	45 per centum
\$21,000 or more, but less than \$22,500	40 per centum
\$22,500 or more, but less than \$23,500	35 per centum
\$23,500 or more, but less than \$24,400	30 per centum
\$24,400 or more, but less than \$25,300	25 per centum
\$25,300 or more, but less than \$26,200	20 per centum
\$26,200 or more, but less than \$27,100	15 per centum
\$27,100 or more, but less than \$28,000	10 per centum
\$28,000 or more, but less than \$28,900	5 per centum


