

LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1964

A LOCAL LAW OF THE COUNTY OF CLINTON FOR THE YEAR 1964 TO PROVIDE FOR LEGALIZING AND VALIDATING CERTAIN CLAIMS AGAINST THE TOWN OF PLATTSBURGH

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Clinton as follows:

Section 1. A Local Law No. 3 of the Year 1964, of this County entitled "A LOCAL LAW OF THE COUNTY OF CLINTON FOR THE YEAR 1964 TO PROVIDE FOR LEGALIZING AND VALIDATING CERTAIN CLAIMS AGAINST THE TOWN OF PLATTSBURGH AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT THEREOF AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF OBLIGATIONS FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF."

Section 2. Claims incurred by the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Plattsburgh prior to 1964 for Town Highway purposes in the sum of \$18,656.06 pursuant to Subdivision (1) of Section 227 of the County Law in excess of the total amount appropriated are hereby legalized and validated.

Section 3. The Town of Plattsburgh is hereby authorized to pay said claims hereinabove described.

Section 4. The Town of Plattsburgh is hereby authorized to issue Serial Bonds for the payment of said claims hereinabove legalized, validated and authorized for payment. Such Serial Bonds shall be issued pursuant to Subdivision 33 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, and the period of probable usefulness thereof shall be three years, and such Serial Bonds shall be issued not later than November 1, 1964 in an amount no greater than \$9,606.06.

Section 5. That the Town of Plattsburgh be authorized to use the sum of \$9,050.00 which was inadvertently placed in the 1964 budget of the Town of Plattsburgh for the payment of said claim.

Section 6. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
