Inmate Populations for 2010: Altona Correctional Facility (Altona Town) was 416, Clinton Correctional Facility (Dannemora Town) was 2,815, and Lyon Mountain Correctional Facility (now closed, was in Dannemora town) was 109.

Clinton County suffered a large population decrease from 1990 to 2000 because of the closure of the Plattsburgh Air Force Base. The closure in effect removed approximately 9,000 active military and their families to bases elsewhere. A majority of the base population was located on the air base (6,689 in 1990), but an additional approximately 2,000 personnel and families lived off base in surrounding communities. Many retired military families that depended upon the base hospital for medical care also moved from the area as a result of the closure. Finally, many civilians that worked on the base were without employment, and had to move to other areas as a result of the closure. The total population lost as a result of the base closure is roughly estimated at 10,000 people.

Although the base closure was a major blow to the area's population base and economy, there have been steady increases in employment and housing opportunities within the County as a result of the reuse of the base properties, as well as a steady increase in employment opportunities in industries and businesses not associated with the base property, and new housing starts throughout the County. These increases have infilled much of the lost population from the base closure, and are expected to continue.

Population Estimate 2020: Straight percentage change between 2000 and 2010 was utilized for all towns except Altona / Dannemora, where the inmate population was subtracted from both figures and instead the 2010 inmate population was kept the same for 2020. All numbers rounded to the nearest 50.
