Any bidder upon returning such set in good condition within thirty (30) days of the date of receiving bids will be refunded his payment, and any non-bidder upon so returning such set in good condition will be refunded half of their deposits. Checks to obtain Bidding Documents shall be made payable to Clinton County Treasurer.

Each bid must be accompanied by security in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information For Bidders. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of opening thereof.

This is a time and materials project, and Bidders shall not include in their bid sales and compensating use taxes on the cost of materials which are to be incorporated into the work and which are to be separately sold by the Contractor to the County of Clinton prior to incorporation into the work of the Contracts.

The attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under these contracts.

The right is reserved to waive any informalities in the Bid and to reject any or all Bids.
