**NARRATIVE:** On the above date and time, Sheriff's Deputies arrested Paul J. Potts and Danielle Potts on the above listed charges following an incident at the Clinton County Fair. It's alleged that the Potts' became disorderly and obstructed Deputies attempts to investigate an alleged assault that was reported to Deputies working on the fairgrounds. It's also alleged that Paul Potts lunged at and head butted a Deputy in the face following his arrest. The Deputy was not injured.

**DISPOSITION:** Danielle Potts was processed at the Sheriff's Fair Office and released after being issued appearance tickets. Paul Potts was processed at the Sheriff's Office and arraigned in Town of Plattsburgh Court, following which was released on his own recognizances. They are both set to appear in Town of Plattsburgh Court on a later date.
