NARRATIVE: On February 29, 2016, Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report of a motor vehicle accident on State Route 22 near the intersection with Ashley Road in the Town of Beekmantown. An investigation at the scene determined that Jeramey Regimbald was operating a 2006 Toyota Scion TC south on Ashley Road, when he failed to observe and negotiate a curve near the intersection with State Route 22 and exited the roadway causing him to strike several earth embankments and a utility pole.

DISPOSITION: Regimbald was treated at the scene for complaint of arm pain and several minor abrasions. Two children, who were also in vehicle, were uninjured in the crash. Sheriff's Deputies were assisted at the scene was Beekmantown Fire Department and CVPH EMS. The operated was cited for Failure to Keep Right and Uninspected Motor Vehicle.
