**NARRATIVE:** On April 6, 2016, Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report of a motor vehicle accident on State Route 22 near the intersection with Military Turnpike in the Town of Peru. An investigation at the scene determined that Sabrina Symonds was operating a 2005 Subaru Forrester north on State Route 22 when she lost control of her vehicle after passing another vehicle. Sabrina's vehicle exited the eastern side of the roadway where it rolled several times before coming to a rest in a field.

**DISPOSITION:** Sabrina Symonds was transported to UVM Health Network CVPH Medical Center by CVPH EMS with a head injury and complaints of pain in her neck and lower body. At the time of this press release, she had been released from the hospital. Symonds was ticketed for speed not reasonable and prudent and for moving from lane unsafely. She was issued tickets to appear in Town of Peru Court on a later date. Deputies were assisted at the scene by CVPH EMS, Peru Fire Department and Keeseville Fire Department.
