A local boy narrowly escaped serious injury after being hit by a large piece of falling ice.

Deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office responding to a 911 call at a residence on Auger Lake Road in Keeseville just before 3:00pm yesterday discovered a 5-year-old boy who had become trapped beneath a large chunk of ice.

The young boy was outside playing with his brother at the time he was struck by a large piece of ice that broke free from a nearby roof. Deputies were able to remove the ice from the boy before EMS arrived. The ice chunk was estimated to have weighed about 250 pounds.

The boy was transported to CVPH medical center and was later released. He suffered no serious injuries from the incident
